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## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### WHERE DO WE PARK?

#### Garage Parking

There are two parking garages, easily accessible from Farnam Street, Harney Street, Dodge Street and 33rd Street. For Jazz on the Green event days only\*, garage parking is free from 5-11pm\*\*. Employees and patrons of the surrounding businesses and apartment residents occupy many of these spots until approximately 5pm. Your best chance to find a garage parking space will be after 5pm. \*Free event parking is applicable ONLY to Jazz on the Green events. 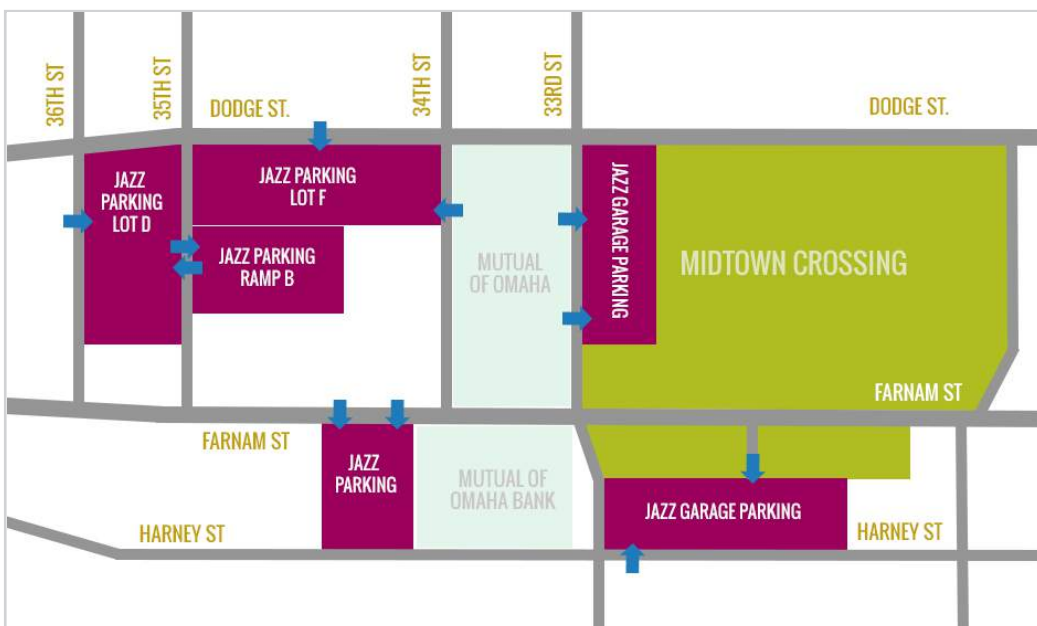
\*\*At 11pm, parking returns to our normal validation system, effective from the time of arrival. Customers may enjoy three (3) hours of free parking with retail validation (available at any retail location in Midtown Crossing with any purchase). Fees are \$1 for each hour thereafter (with a maximum fee of \$10 per 24 hour period).

#### Mutual of Omaha

Mutual of Omaha will have its surface parking lots open to the public for free beginning at 5pm. Mutual of Omaha's surface lots are located at 36th and Dodge Streets; between 35th Avenue and 24th Street off of Dodge; and at 35th and Farnam Streets.

#### Street Parking

Metered street parking is available along Farnam Street and around the perimeter of Turner Park, accessible from 31st Avenue. Metered parking is short-term (2 hours maximum) and is monitored Monday-Saturday from 9am-9pm.



# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## WHAT IS THE COST TO ATTEND?

All of the events in Turner Park are FREE and open to the public. All you have to do is show up!

## WHERE AND WHEN CAN WE ARRIVE AND SIT DOWN?

For our summer events, the main part of the park typically opens for seating at 5pm unless otherwise noted. You may sit in the outer area of the park at anytime. For emergency purposes, sitting on the roads and sidewalks will not be permitted. See above for reference.

## WILL THERE BE FOOD AND BEVERAGES AVAILABLE?

Yes! A number of our Midtown Crossing restaurants will be setting up tents and selling some of their fares for you to enjoy.

## WHAT CAN WE BRING INTO TURNER PARK?

### **We encourage you to bring the following items:**

- Blankets and chairs. Make your experience more comfortable with cozy blankets or chairs.
- Sun screen. The sun may be pretty intense while you wait for the event to start.
- Flat shoes. Remember, you'll be on the grass and high heels will sink into the ground.

### **Please DO NOT bring the following items:**

- Tents. They affect the view of the other guests.
- Tarps. They kill the grass.
- Stakes. They present a tripping hazard.
- Open flames. (i.e. no hibachis and citronella candles).
- Hard liquor. Only beer, wine and champagne are allowed in Turner Park.

Outside Food and Beverages: We do allow you to bring in your own food and beverages, excluding any hard liquor.

Pets: Pets are allowed in Turner park but must be leashed at all times. Please clean up after your pet.
